Academic Plagiarism

Academic Plagiarism is a service provided by the library to detect plagiarism in student assignments. Papers can be uploaded by faculty, or if allowed, by students for plagiarism checking.

Send requests to ReferenceRequest@ctcd.edu and include “**Academic Plagiarism**” in the subject line. The library will provide you with instructions and the institution code required to establish an account.

Services for Faculty

Interlibrary Loan : Interlibrary loan materials are borrowed from other academic libraries. The ILL department can locate books and journal articles which are NOT owned in CTC’s collection. This service is a great way to obtain materials you may need to further your personal research at no cost.

Suggest a Purchase : Please feel to suggest print or electronic books, journals, and other materials that can help you or your students.

TexShare : This program allows participating libraries to extend free, reciprocal borrowing privileges to each other's patrons. Please come in to the Library to sign-up for your TexShare card.

Course Reserves : This service allows professors to put course material on reserve at the Library circulation desk so that faculty members and students are able to check them out. E-Reserves are also available.
